9. Is the age of the narrator when she received the letter from a parents. 100 000 : is the number of the Chinese children adopted by Western families.
12 : the narrator was 12 years old when she first went to China.
10. Thrilled – protective – responsible

The narrator was thrilled to meet his natural parents for the first time. She is protective towards her brother. She does not want him to be alone when he arrived at the airport. She is responsible because she contacted the agency to find out the time of his arrival. (any answer similar to these will be accepted).
